The contractor must obtain a separate certificate for each tax-exempt construction project. A prime (general) contractor must obtain one certificate for the project and issue copies of the certificate to any subcontractor performing work for the project.</p> <p>Just a reminder, this exemption does not include or apply to the purchase or rental of equipment, supplies, appliances, and materials that are purchased, rented, or consumed by the contractor and which do not become a part of the structure, highway, road, street, or other public works owned and used by the exempt organization.
