## SSRC-GONDOLA CLIMBING WALL DECK

In response to your email questions dated May 16, 2017:

**Building construction type classification:** 

- 1. You noted a type V-1 hr rating from permit SB-89-039. More recently, the building permit application for SSRC Lower Gondola KVC Addition in 2009 using the 2003 IBC described this building as a structure containing two buildings separated by a two-hour fire separation wall. Both buildings were classified as Type 5-B, NFPA 13 fire sprinkler system.
- 2. That two-hour separation is at the south side of the gondola bay. The gondola bay consists of all exposed decking and structural framing. No fire rating. But does have fire sprinkler.
- 3. Gondola queuing area adjacent to this new outdoor deck area has a wood ceiling and no fire sprinkler system.
- **4.** Outside deck/exit walkway for stair tower has exposed steel beam, wood soffit and no fire sprinkler system.
- 5. This proposed deck is entirely outside the building. We feel that the deck is code compliant as designed.

Climbing wall description: (To follow once received. Hopefully this portion will not affect approval of the deck.)
