- All workers are required to read and comply with this COVID-19 Construction Site Management Plan before starting any work activity. Please contact the Site Superintendent if there are any questions or concerns.
- Only essential personnel who are hired to be on-site are allowed on the project jobsite.
- Any worker new to the project jobsite is required to contact the Site Superintendent prior to entering the project jobsite.
- Any worker experiencing illness symptoms are not allowed to be on the project jobsite and should not report to work, this includes common cold symptoms.
- At any time throughout the workday, any worker who develops symptoms related to an illness must leave immediately and inform the Site Superintendent and their employer.
- Safety glasses and gloves are required to be worn at all times.
- No more than Five (5) workers shall be on site or within the building at any given time, check with the Site Superintendent on how many workers are currently on each project site or within each building prior to entering.
- It is required to practice and maintain social distancing at all times, including lunchtime and break time, by maintaining six feet (6'-0) separation from others.
- All Safety Tool Box Talks are to take place outdoors while maintaining social distancing of six feet, attendance will be taken by the Foreman or Site Superintendent.
- Do not congregate during break time or lunchtime.
- No handshaking, fist bumps, or other contact greetings are allowed.
- Hand sanitizer, hand washing stations, and other essential cleaning supplies on the jobsite and shall be used prior to break time and lunch, or as needed.
- It is recommended all workers should change their clothes prior to arriving home, and wash clothes in hot water with laundry detergent/sanitizer.
