

Posting Surrounding Property Owner Notification Affidavit - Planning Applications

Property Posting (the sign) is required within seven days of a complete application being
accepted by the Planning Department and shall remain on the property until a decision is made.
The Applicant shall submit this affidavit no later than 10 days following acceptance of a
complete application confirming such notification has been provided. Review of any application
requiring public notice may be delayed in the event this affidavit is not received.
