Artist Statement:

The artwork at Riverview celebrates the magical landscape of the Valley, highlighting significant features that make Steamboat so special. The main focus of the mural will be a conglomeration of landscape features recognizable to Routt County. It will essentially be a “map” in artistic form, (not geographically correct.) This “map” will be split between the two mural locations, so the murals will be separate physically but connect in their design. From far left, Rabbit Ears monument flows into Mt. Werner Ski Mountain, with the Yampa River winding through the hills into town. This will then connect to the right mural as the river descends “west” over towards Sleeping Giant Mountain, combining with the Elk River winding down from the North. Lastly, Hanns Peak appears in the distance on the far right. Added details include Aspen groves in the foreground, mountain animals grazing in the grassy fields, and rafters floating down the rippling river.

Materials used:

Primer coating over concrete, acrylic paint, with sealer/ varnish (non-yellowing , anti-graffiti longevity sealer).
